**WHAT:** AN EVENING JAZZ CONCERT The Barbary Coast Dixieland Show Band presents the best of traditional and contemporary jazz. They play the fun music of the Roarin' Twenties, Flirty Thirties and Swinging Forties that have audiences singing and dancing. Featuring musicians with multi-instrument talent (6 musicians & 18 instruments) they will switch instruments in mid-tune without missing a beat!

**WHO:** THE BARBARY COAST SHOW BAND This renowned Dixieland Band has performed all over the world, from the Minnesota State Fair to riverboats on the Mississippi to Nagasaki, Japan. Led by banjoist Dick Petersen, the band has been playing on the U.S. festival circuit since 1967 and are in the Minnesota Music Hall of Fame, joining such luminaries as Bob Dylan, Judy Garland and Prince. They have been repeat performers at the Suncoast Jazz Classic held at Clearwater Beach each November.

**ABOUT THIS EVENT:** While this event is not part of its regular "second Sunday" afternoon concert series, Peace Memorial Church is lending its excellent acoustic space to host this special musical event for all to enjoy. The band is making a special downtown appearance courtesy of the Suncoast Jazz Classic where it will be featured with 15 other leading festival bands at the Sheraton Sand Key Resort and Marriott Suites on Nov. 21-23. **WHERE:** Peace Memorial Presbyterian Church (the pink church downtown) at 110 S. Ft. Harrison Ave., Clwr. (corner of Pierce and Ft. Harrison).

**CHARGE:** No tickets needed and seating is first come, first served. An offering will be taken in support of the Suncoast Jazz Fest's young musician scholarships, to support the church's regular Sunday afternoon music series and to defray the church's facility costs. A donation of \$5- \$10 is suggested. Doors will open at 6:30.

**RECEPTION:** After the concert, there is a light reception in the fellowship hall so you can meet, greet and thank the musicians.

**PARKING:** There are four primary areas: 1) west and behind the church off of Pierce 2) directly east across Ft Harrison in large County lot (reserved for Peace church events on Sundays) 3) in lot north of the church fellowship hall and 4) west in the City Hall lot.
